Sympathetic chain -Eyes, ears and other sense organs; glands and blood vessels of the brain; immune response; bone growth; fat metabolism; reaction to stress; brain function

- OC4 Nose, lips, mouth, eustachian tube, mucous membranes, lungs
- OC5 Vocal cords, neck glands, pharynx
- O C6 Neck muscles, shoulders, tonsils
- OC7 Thyroid gland, bursa in the shoulders, elbows
- T1 Arms from the elbows down, including hands, arms, wrists and fingers; esophagus and trachea; heart
- O T2 Heart, including its valves and covering; coronary arteries; lungs; bronchial tubes
- O T3 Lungs, bronchial tubes, pleura, chest, breast, heart
- 77 Pancreas, duodenum, stomach, liver, spleen, gallbladder, peritoneum
- **78** Spleen, stomach, liver, pancreas, gallbladder, adrenal cortex, small intestine, pyloric valve
- 19 Adrenal cortex, pancreas, spleen, gallbladder, ovaries, uterus, small intestine
- OL1 Large intestine, inguinal rings, uterus
- O L2 Appendix, abdomen, upper leg, bladder
- O L3 Sex organs, uterus, bladder, knees, prostate, large intestine
- O L4 Prostate gland, muscles of the lower back, sciatic nerve
- O L5 Lower legs, ankles, feet, prostate
- O Sacrum Hip bones, buttocks, rectum, sex organs, genitalia, bladder, ureter, prostate
- O Coccyx Rectum, anus

- OC1 Blood supply to the head, pituitary gland, scalp, bones of the face, brain, inner and middle ear, sympathetic nervous system and eyes
- O C2 Eyes, optic nerves, auditory nerves, sinuses, tongue, forehead, heart
- OC3 Cheeks, outer ear, face, teeth, facial nerve, lungs
- **Description** Brachial plexus Forms the radial, ulnar, median and other nerves that go to the muscles, joints and other structures of the shoulder, arm, wrist, hand and fingers
 - O 14 Gallbladder, common duct, heart, lungs, bronchial tubes
 - O **T5** Liver, solar plexus, circulation (general), heart, esophagus, stomach
 - O T6 Stomach, esophagus, peritoneum, duodenum
 - O T10 Kidneys, appendix, testes, ovaries, uterus, adrenal cortex, spleen, pancreas, large intestine
 - → T11 Kidneys, ureters, large intestine, bladder, adrenal medulla, adrenal cortex, uterus, ovaries, ileocecal valve
 - O T12 Small intestine, lymph circulation, large intestine, bladder, uterus, kidneys, ileocecal valve
 - O Sacral plexus Forms the sciatic and other nerves that go to the muscles, joints and other structures of the leg, knee, ankle, feet and toes
